WHEREAS, the Marine City Commission ("Commission") received and verified sufficient petitions requesting the matter of Resolution 08-2015 be placed on the ballot for voter approval; and

WHEREAS, the Commission resolved at its regular meeting of December 3, 2015 to place the question on the ballot of the election scheduled March 8, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the Commission must provide the St. Clair County Clerk with language for the question to be placed before city electors on the March 8, 2016 ballot.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that:

The question put to the electors of the City of Marine City shall state:

Shall the City of Marine City establish a Special Assessment District pursuant to Michigan Public Act 33 of 1951, as amended, consisting of all the lands and premises within the municipal boundaries of the city for a period of five years with the City Commission determining annually a levy amount between zero (0) and five (5) mills to defray the costs necessary to continue maintenance of police and fire protection?
